

SIO Presenter Conflict of Interest Mitigation Policy

The Society of Interventional Oncology (SIO) requires that all presenters for CME-eligible educational events disclose any financial relationships that may impact their ability to speak freely from biases at the time of their acceptance of an invitation to present.

Any financial disclosures from presenters are reviewed by SIO Education staff using <u>the ACCME Conflict</u> <u>Mitigation Worksheet</u> to determine whether the disclosed conflict of interest can be mitigated or if a replacement presenter is needed.

Additionally, all CME-eligible educational event presenters are instructed by SIO Education staff to take an industry-agnostic approach to developing their content and to share data obtained using a variety of tools and methods so as not to favor any one company or product over another.
